Newsletter – Limocar announces the relocation of its services to downtown Montreal and an update to its schedules effective May 4, 2026

Limocar would like to inform its customers that, effective May 4, 2026, the service point currently located at the Montreal Bus Terminal will be relocated to downtown Montreal, specifically to the service point already listed on the schedule at 800 De La Gauchetière Street West.

This location, situated at the heart of a major transportation hub, offers direct access to the Central Station, the REM, the VIA Rail network, commuter trains, and the bus networks operated by exo, the RTL, and the STM, as well as the Montreal metro via the Bonaventure station. This relocation improves intermodal connectivity and facilitates transfers for most public transit users. It also aims to save time by providing a central, easily accessible service point.

An updated schedule will accompany this relocation, based on the new operating conditions, to optimize connections with the various modes of public transit. The lead time until May 4 will allow customers to plan their trips accordingly.

In the absence of a viable agreement with the Montreal Bus Terminal, the company had no choice but to leave its current facilities to avoid raising ticket prices for passengers.

To help mitigate the impact of this change, a 15% discount applicable to a future purchase will be offered to all customers.
